

# Quick Guide to upgrade Android 4.4.4 to 7.1.1(LineageOS 14.1 Android and Android TV)



To upgrade Android 4.4.4 to [LineageOS 14.1](#), you have to update or install the latest version of Android 4.4.4.

This guide be applied to the [LineageOS 14.1](#) Android and Android TV.

You can upgrade the android from 4.4.4 to 7.1.1 by using ODR0ID Updater.

## How to upgrade

1. Open **the browser on your ODR0ID-XU4** and copy the latest [LineageOS 14.1](#) update.zip file URL **from the forum page**.

Known issues  
 USB-3G Now you can use 3G/4G HLink modems(e.g Huawei E3372) [more info](#)  
 Only Bluetooth low energy v4.0(BLE) modules are supported at this moment. [See Bluetooth Module 2](#)

How to install.  
 For first time you need prepare your emmc/sd with special selfinstall images.  
 You can find it here

Write proper image to your sd via Etcher/Win32DiskImager  
[http://odroid.com/dokuwiki/doku.php?id=...hing\\_tools](http://odroid.com/dokuwiki/doku.php?id=...hing_tools)  
 Don't write any selfinstall image to EMMC! Use microsd and sd2emmc image to install Android on your EMMC

How-to update (from latest Android 4.4.4 or LineageOS-14.1 Alpha-1.x)  
 URL for ODR0ID-updater App. Copy & Paste this URL into the ODR0ID-Updater URL box :

Patiently wait long time in the first booting process. Update process might take up to 20 minutes.

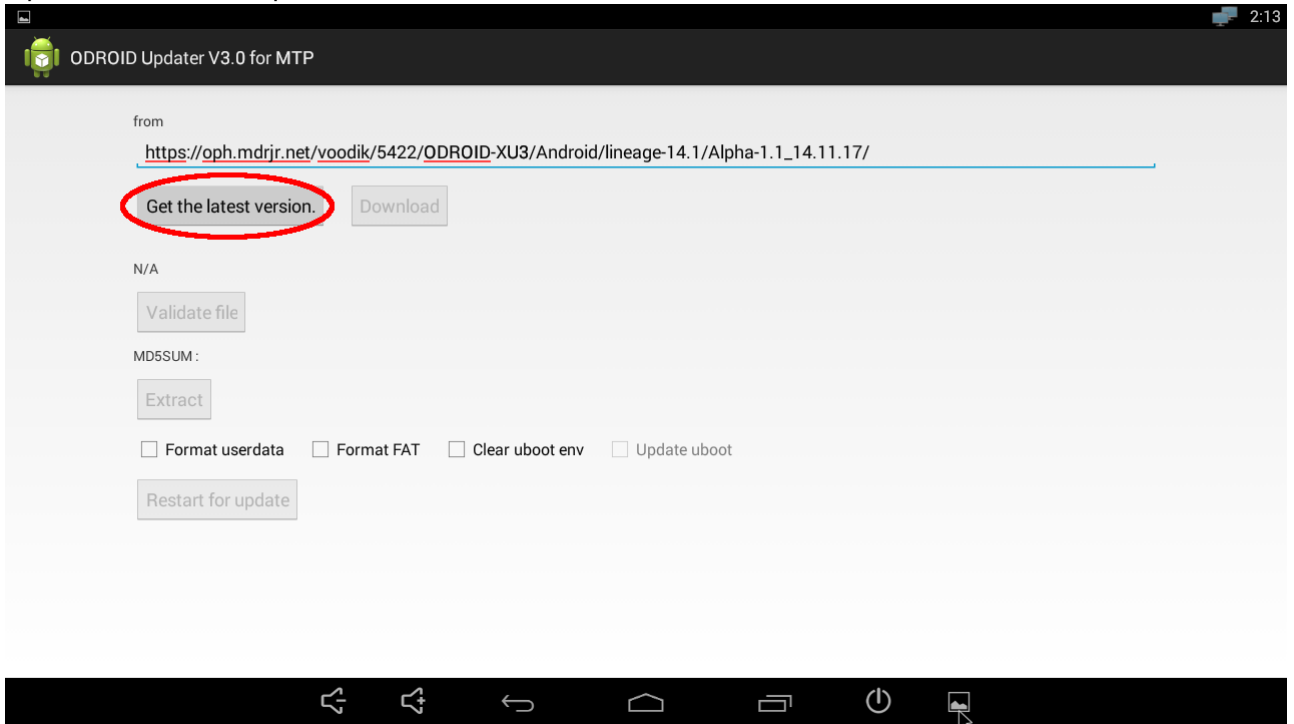

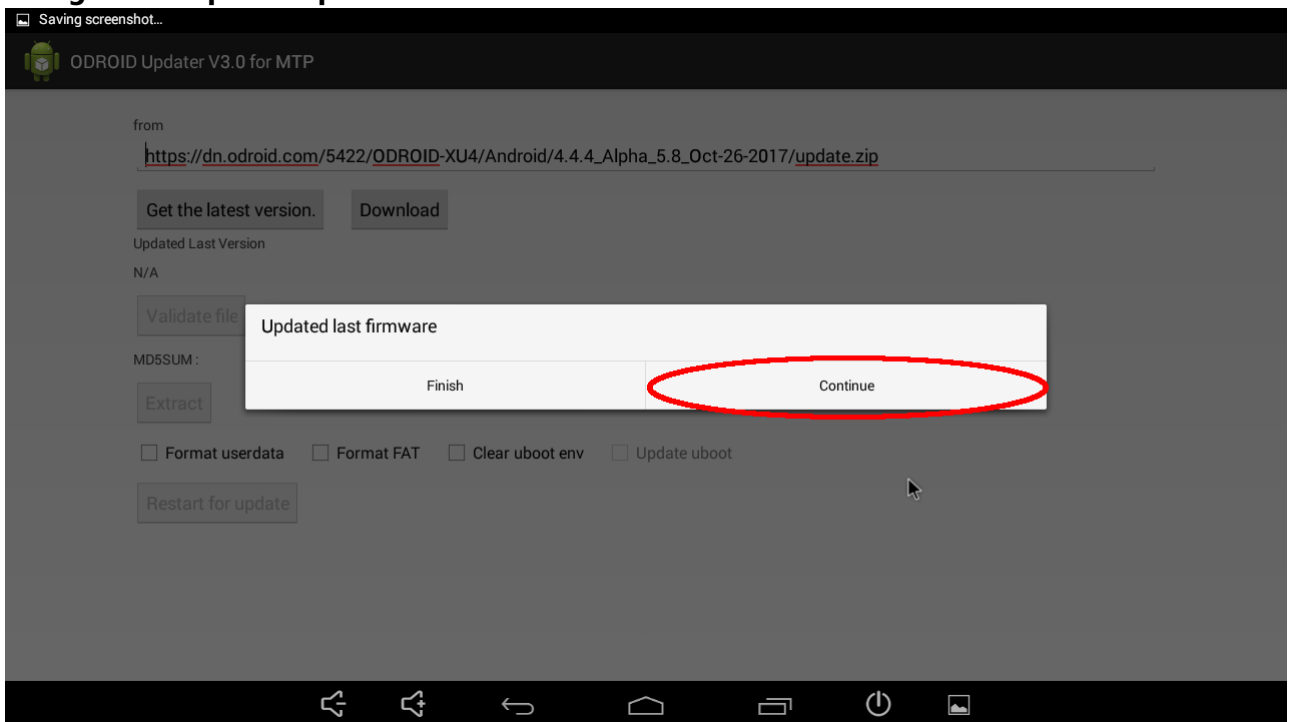


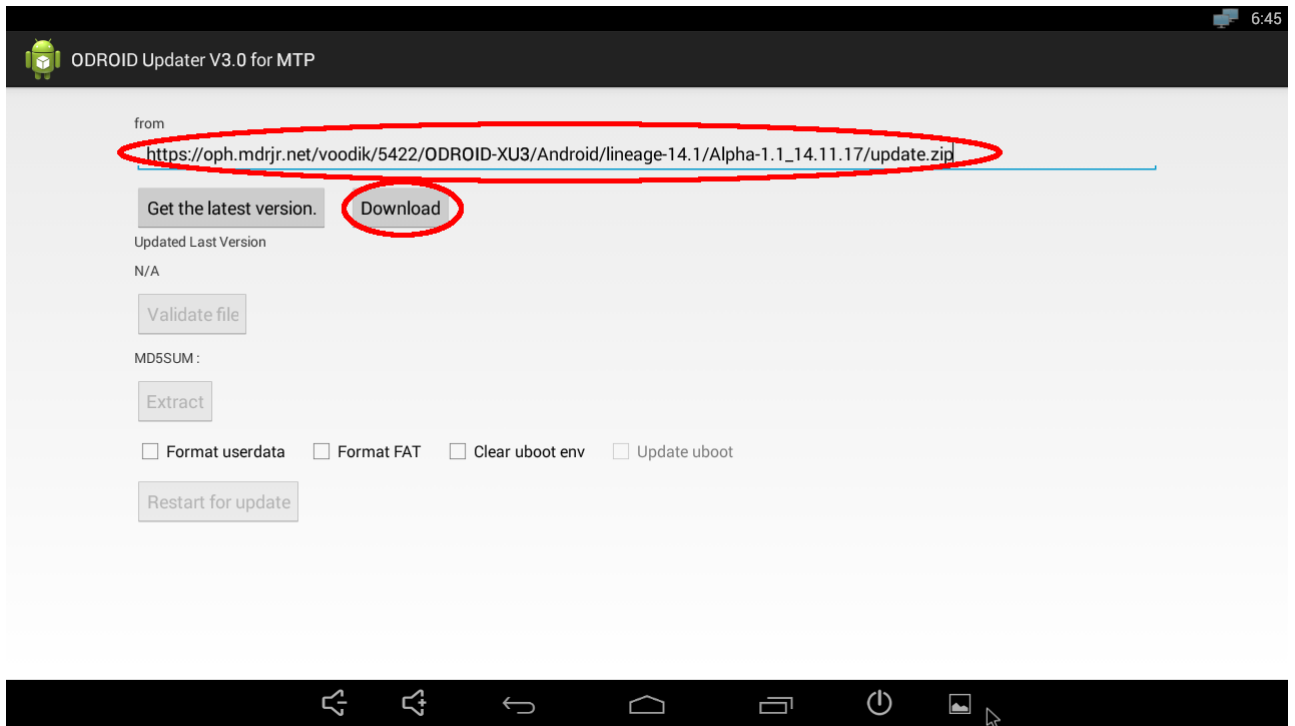

2. Open the ODROID Updater. and click "Get the latest version." Button.

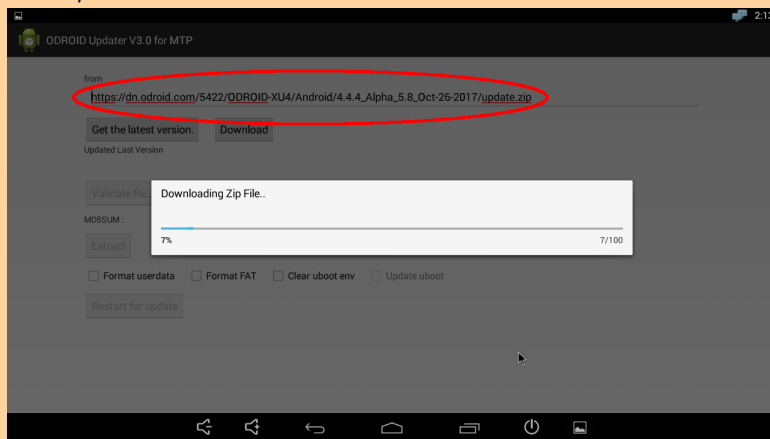


3. Click "continue" button. **and change the URL from default Android update.zip URL to Linage 14.1 updatezip URL.**

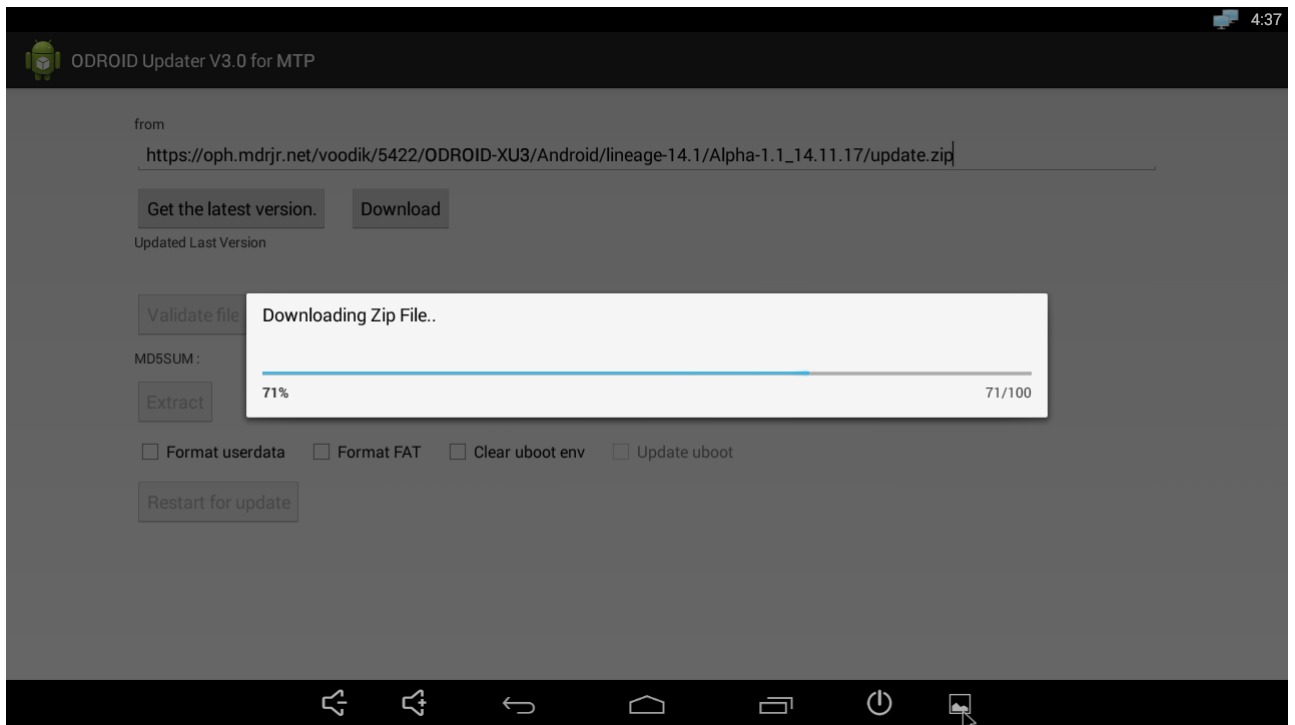




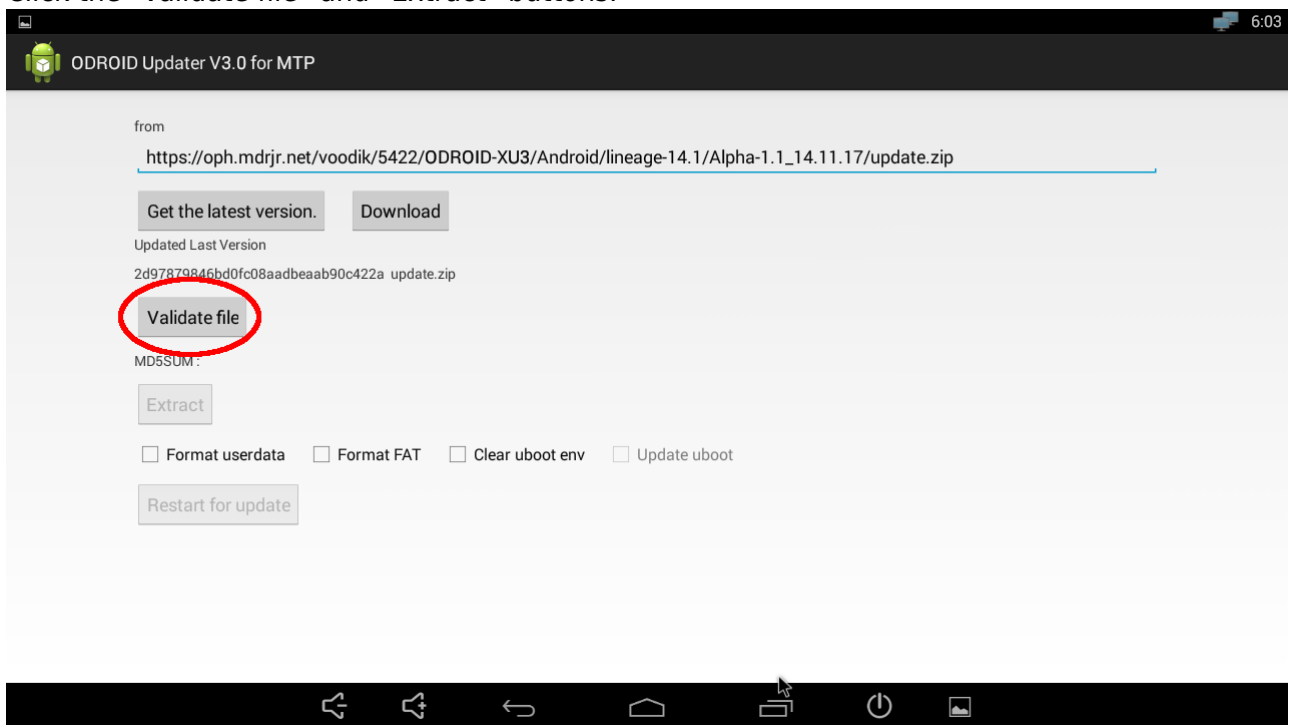
You ave to change the URL **after** click the **“Get the latest version.”** button.  
If not, it download the latest **Android 4.4.4.**

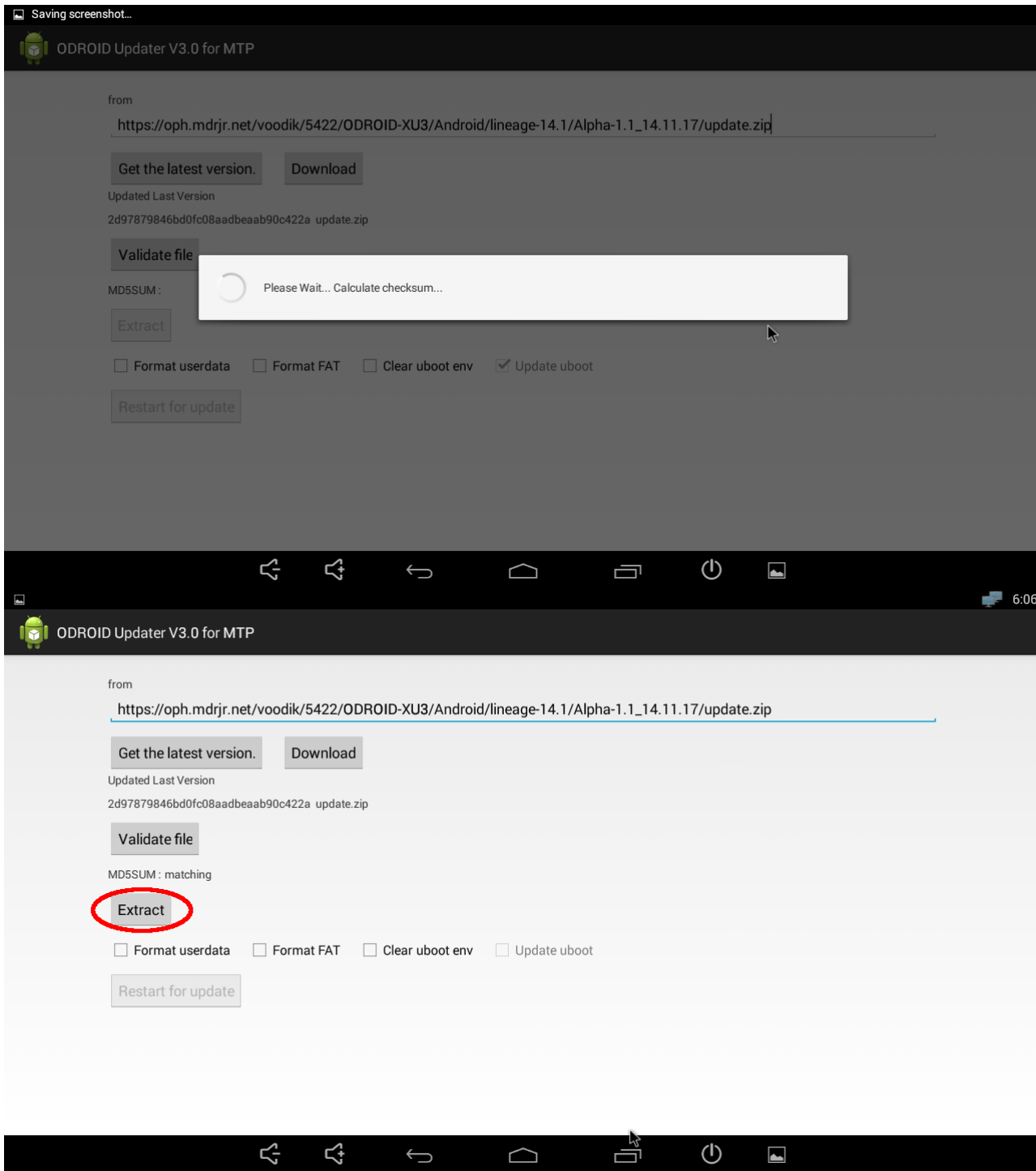


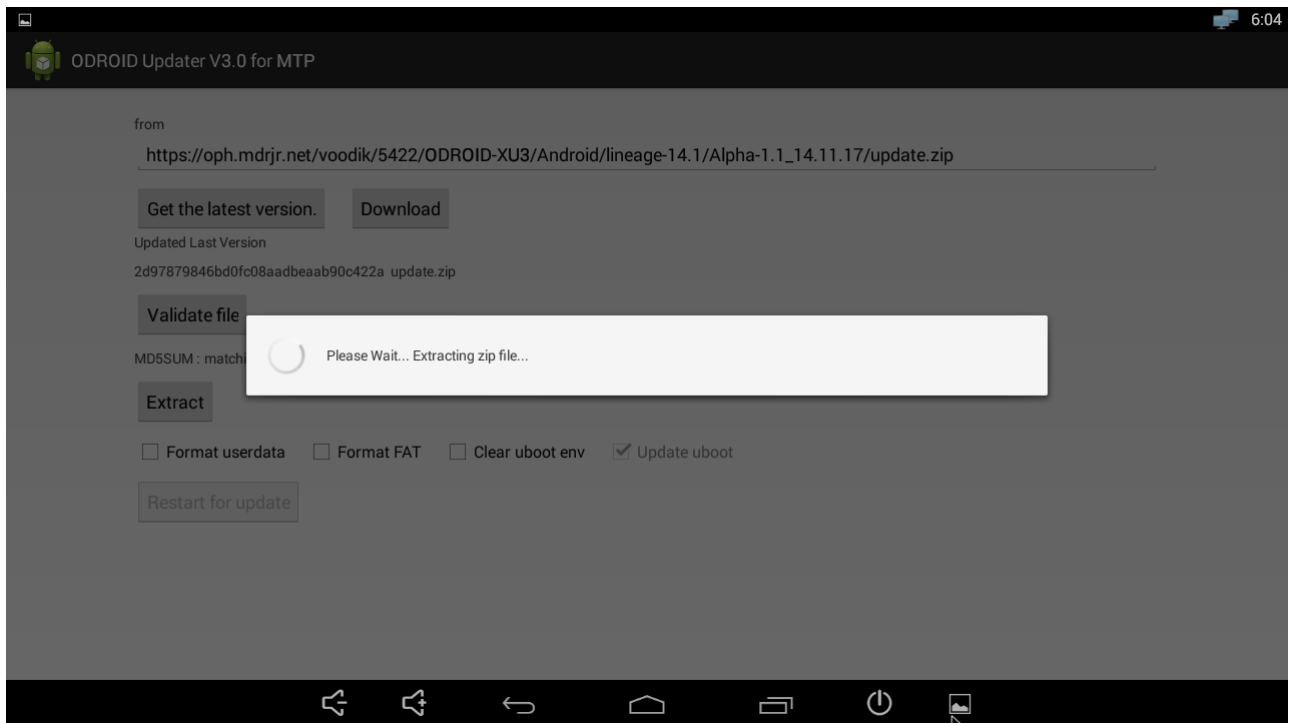
4. Click the “Download” button to download the update image. It take a long time.



5. Click the "validate file" and "Extract" buttons.







6. Check the “Format userdata” and “Update uboot”.



7. Click the “Restart for update” button to upgrade the Android.
